

SUMMER BOOK GROUP



ADULT FORMUM

This past March, both houses of New Jersey's legislature passed bills to legalize assisted suicide in our state, in certain circumstances. On Sundays at 9 AM, April 28 – May 26, Pastor Erhardt is leading a study of what Christian theology tells us about how to love a person as they near death. We will use the LCMS Commission on Theology and Church Relations (CTCR)'s 1993 report, Christian Care at *Life's End*, to guide our discussion. UPDATE ON THE WHEELCHAIR

Messiah has contracted with the Abby Lift Co. to replace our wheelchair lift in the parish building. The project will require significant modification to the existing lift area, mainly to accommodate a door on the basement level. We expect that the work will be completed this spring, and will cost \$15–17,000. Because the Executive Board has been a careful steward of Messiah's financial resources, we do not plan to have a fundraising campaign for this project. Donations are certainly appreciated, however.
