

#### Missions Medical and Spiritual

Last month, I entitled this column, *Light at the End of the Tunnel*, looking forward to the lessening of the Covid threat and restrictions. This month, I'm happy to report that we're making gradual progress on that front. We're adapting to live with Covid like we do with measles, and vaccination is a key part of prevention. If you haven't receive a vaccination appointment yet and haven't already registered for one at the following websites, I encourage you to do so:

Once your phase is eligible to be vaccinated, also check the Princeton Medical Center website periodically for appointment availability: princetonhcs.org

We're making good progress on the vaccination front at Messiah. Just about every week, more of us are getting appointments. So don't despair — make sure you are registered, and your turn will come.

As Covid vaccination progresses, we will gradually increase the number of in-person activities we offer. To make time for music rehearsal before Sunday worship services and to ease the transition to Daylight Saving Time, Sunday worship time will change from 9:30am to 10:00am beginning Sunday, March 14.

On **Easter Sunday (April 4) only,** we will have an outdoor service at 8:30am (weather permitting), followed by an indoor service at 11am.

Until we have all had a chance to be vaccinated, in worship services please continue to wear masks and maintain six feet of distance between you and members of other households.




